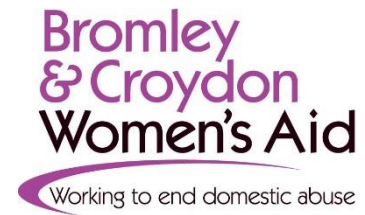


Bromley & Croydon Women's Aid

Bromley Women's Aid provides safe, secure, high quality temporary accommodation and support services to women escaping Domestic Violence and abuse. It was established in 1975 by a group of local concerned and committed women.



BCWA aims to empower anyone suffering domestic abuse so they can make informed choices about their future. Their services are confidential, non-judgmental and respectful of diversity.

BCWA puts anyone who contacts them for support at the heart of decision making, so that they can gain the confidence, strength and self-respect needed to free themselves from abusive relationships.

The charity provides support and advice in the following areas:

- Housing and legal proceedings
- Welfare benefits
- Emotional and practical support in moving towards independence
- Access to professional counselling
- Support for women experiencing mental health issues or disabilities as well as domestic violence
- Support for women from diverse ethnic backgrounds experiencing domestic violence
- Access to translation services
- Access to Health Visitors, schools, and other external agencies
