

London Borough of Bromley & NHS South East London, Integrated Commissioning Board Innovation Fund

- A funding opportunity to trial and test new and innovative ideas to address current needs and targeting gaps in service delivery and help to improve outcomes and self-management
- Aim is to support prevention and early intervention projects,
- The fund is non-recurrent, as the intention is to support organisations to test ideas and concepts, whilst presenting a parallel plan on how funded services will potentially be developed and sustained without Innovation Funding in the longer term

Current Priorities

Aligned to the Bromley Corporate Strategy and the Adult Care & Health Portfolio Plan and overarching aim to prioritise Health, & Wellbeing:

- Reducing social isolation, loneliness & support to improve health and wellbeing
- Providing day opportunities for vulnerable adults and older people and support the role of carers
- Supporting young people (16+) as they transition into adulthood
- Promoting and supporting volunteering

Funding & Period

- Set by LBB & NHS each financial year
- Not for core service ongoing costs or meeting higher level demand
- Normally projects that run 1 year; sometimes 2-year projects may be considered
- Up to £50,000. may be available

Eligibility

- Voluntary, community or not-for-profit organisations based or operate in Bromley for the benefit of Bromley residents
- Ordinarily organisations can only apply once in a financial year

Applications & time line

- All applications submitted on line via CLB platform
- Normally a round is opened each quarter from March, June, September & December
- Detailed time line of process will be published for each round

Finance & Monitoring

- Funds paid quarterly in arrears, and some start-up funding may be negotiated
- Regular monitoring agreed in project award letters
