

JusB

JusB is a community-based youth centre. Their mission is to inspire and enable young people to develop, be confident and value themselves. Normally this is delivered through a range of youth groups and holiday projects as well as one-to-one advice and guidance. The regular groups provide facilities to do homework, a fully equipped music studio with a specialist tutor to help develop new skills, support in making the difficult move from primary to secondary school as well as safe spaces to chillout with friends and discuss issues they are facing with peers and experienced youth workers. Some of these activities are currently restricted as working within Covid-19 secure guidelines, but JusB have still managed to deliver a service for young people throughout the whole pandemic.



The projects that are offered are open to all young people aged 10-19, most of those the youth centre work with are hard to reach, vulnerable, facing problems or dealing with challenging circumstances. JusB helps them navigate this difficult stage in their lives and improve their life chances.

Here's what some of JusB's young people have said recently when asked "What would you do if JusB was not here?"

"I'd be bored at home and not socializing, I wouldn't be doing homework, so I'd get in trouble"

"I wouldn't have met people who are now my good friends"

"I'd have to pay to print out sheets for my homework"

"It's made me more comfortable talking to new people, I've made life-long friends"

"I love JusB, it's such a calming place to be"
