- 8. Ratification of new member organisations
 - Beyond Autism is an educational service for children with autism and/or related communication disorders aged 15 months 5 years. It provides families support and empowers parents/carers to be more confident in their own and their child's ability.
 - **Divine Encounter.** The aim of Divine Encounter is the personal development of disadvantaged children and young people and their families in the United Kingdom.
 - Two's Company Befriending Chislehurst is a befriending service aimed at adults who find themselves requiring some extra friendship and support, and this is provided through weekly home visits.
 - <u>Demelza Hospice Care for Children</u> provides residential and community hospice care services and support for life-limited and lifethreatened children, young people and their families.
 - <u>Urban Flyers</u> supports children and young people from disadvantaged backgrounds (whether it be due to ethnicity, race, religion, gender, economical background) to access innovative technology and educational STEM activities alongside being able to explore jobs, training, and career options.
 - Creative and Neuro-diverse Innovations (CANDI) is a non-profit
 Organisation established as a Community Interest Company. This
 organisation is located in Bromley and has a mission to support the
 local community and provide employment, training, entertainment and
 social and communication opportunities for the Neuro-diverse
